

## ABOUT WORLD NETBALL DARTS

This game of World Netball Darts is a magnetic dart game (no more holes) and can and does teach players about the game of netball.

Netball is played mainly in Australia and New Zealand and England and the West Indies. Netball is a game that is mainly played by the girls and watched by the girls, but it is one of the fastest growing games around with a terrific following in those countries that have been mentioned.

Netball is a very fast moving ball game with great skill and fitness required. Boys are starting to play netball a lot more these days in mixed netball competitions and the profile of netball throughout the world is getting more exposure year by year. Netball clubs need to join ranks with football clubs whether they be soccer or aussie rules this way you will get more people watching and participating in both games.

This game of World Netball Darts can help teach you about the rules, plays, tactics, penalties and goal scoring of this great game.

There are more detailed rules and instructions under rules and instructions. You can have one or two or more players playing this game.

if you have 2 or more players then you will just alternate the play between players and if one player is playing then that player will be both teams.

You can have a third person as an umpire to rule on penalties, goal shooting and out of play decisions or you can just umpire between yourselves.

To start play you toss a coin to see who shoots first and which end you shoot to, set your timer for the desired time you would like to play (either 4 quarters or 2 halves) lets say 5 min quarters. the player that wins the toss shoots first so you would shoot into your middle third then onto your attacking third and then into your half circle scoring area then shoot for goal it is as simple as that all you have to do is think Netball and play Netball.

## Instructions for the game of World Netball darts

### ABOUT THE GAME

This game of World Netball Darts is about playing the game of Netball if you know how to play netball then this game will be easy to play if you do not know how to play netball then this game can teach you about the rules, plays and tactics of Netball.

### CONTENTS

Depending on which game you have purchased: if you have purchased a single sided game then you get 8 darts and if you have purchased a double sided game then you get 16 darts. Your game also comes with a timer and rules and instructions and a scorecard all packed in an easy to carry and store tube.

### HANGING THE GAME

You can hang your game anywhere you like, on the back of a door in a tree in the shed or on the lounge room wall with these magnetic safety darts there are no more holes. You can hang your game to suit the players heights and skill level and the distance you throw from can be adjusted as well. The standard height and distance are, from the floor to the centre circle 170 cm or 1.7 metres and the distance you throw from that is 230cm or 2.3 metres.

### PLAYERS

You can have two or more players or you can have one player, if you have one player then that player can be both teams if you have two or more players on both teams then you will just alternate the shots between the players.

### TIMER

Each game comes with a timer so you can play either 4 quarters of netball or two halves you can set your timer at the desired amount of time you would like each quarter or half to go for. The timer has a battery in it either loose or upside down, to set your timer press in the desired mins or secs press start and the timer will count down. When the siren sounds that will be the end of the quarter or the half so press stop and the timer will reset itself, to start the next quarter or half just press start again and game is on.

### UMPIRES

You can have a separate umpire to rule on penalties and frees etc or you can just umpire between yourselves. Remember the umpires decision is final.

### FREES AND PENALTIES

In this game of World Netball any white line that you hit is a penalty to the opposition the opposition shall take their penalty from where the offending dart did land and move on towards their scoring end. If when shooting around the court and you land on an opposition player then this will be called an interception by the opposition and they will have their shot and move on towards their scoring end.

### OUT OF BOUNDS OR PLAY

If when shooting and you land out of court then this will be a free to the opposition and they will have their shot from where the offending dart did land and move onto wards their scoring end.

### **THIRD OF COURT RULE**

In the game of netball you cannot throw or pass more than one third of the court if you do this will be a penalty or a free to the opposition and they will take their shot from where the offending dart was thrown from or let the umpire rule on that decision.

### **SCORING**

There is a score card supplied and an example on how to score in netball one goal = 1 point.

### **SHOOTING FOR GOAL**

When shooting for goal you have to be in the half circle, you shoot into the circle at the end of the court this is the netball ring. You will see on the netball ring that it is divided into 4 quarters 2 black and 2 white, the black means that it is a rebound to the opposition and the white means that it is a rebound to the team / player that is shooting for goal. If when shooting for goal and you miss the netball ring completely but you still land in the scoring half circle you still have control of the ball and you can still shoot for goal, if you shoot for goal and happen to land outside the half circle we will call this a pass but you must return to the half circle before you can shoot for goal. If when shooting into your half circle so you can have a shot for goal and you accidentally score a goal then this is a no goal and a penalty to the opposition.

### **TOSS A COIN**

To start play you can toss a coin to see which player starts first and which end you want to shoot for first so toss your coin set your timer press start and the game is on.

### **START PLAY**

The player that has won the toss starts first so just like in the real game you throw into your middle third first then throw into your attacking third and then into your scoring half circle then you can shoot for goal. If you get the goal the game restarts in the centre (remember to alternate the centre shot after a goal has been scored) if you miss the goal and it goes out of play or hits an opposition player or the opposition rebound then this will be the oppositions shot and they will shoot towards their attacking goals (remember the one third of court rule). There are many plays and tactics in the game of netball and you can make your own up as you play all you have to do is think you are playing on the court and passing the ball from player to player it is as simple as that.

### **SOME PLAY**

You shoot into your middle third, onto your attacking third, into your half circle then shoot for goal, you hit the black line on the netball ring so it is a rebound to the opposition the opposition take the ball shoot into their defensive third onto their middle third onto their attacking third and hit an opposition player a great interception, you shoot into your middle third onto your attacking third into your half circle and shoot for goal, its a goal great play. Thats one goal to zero.

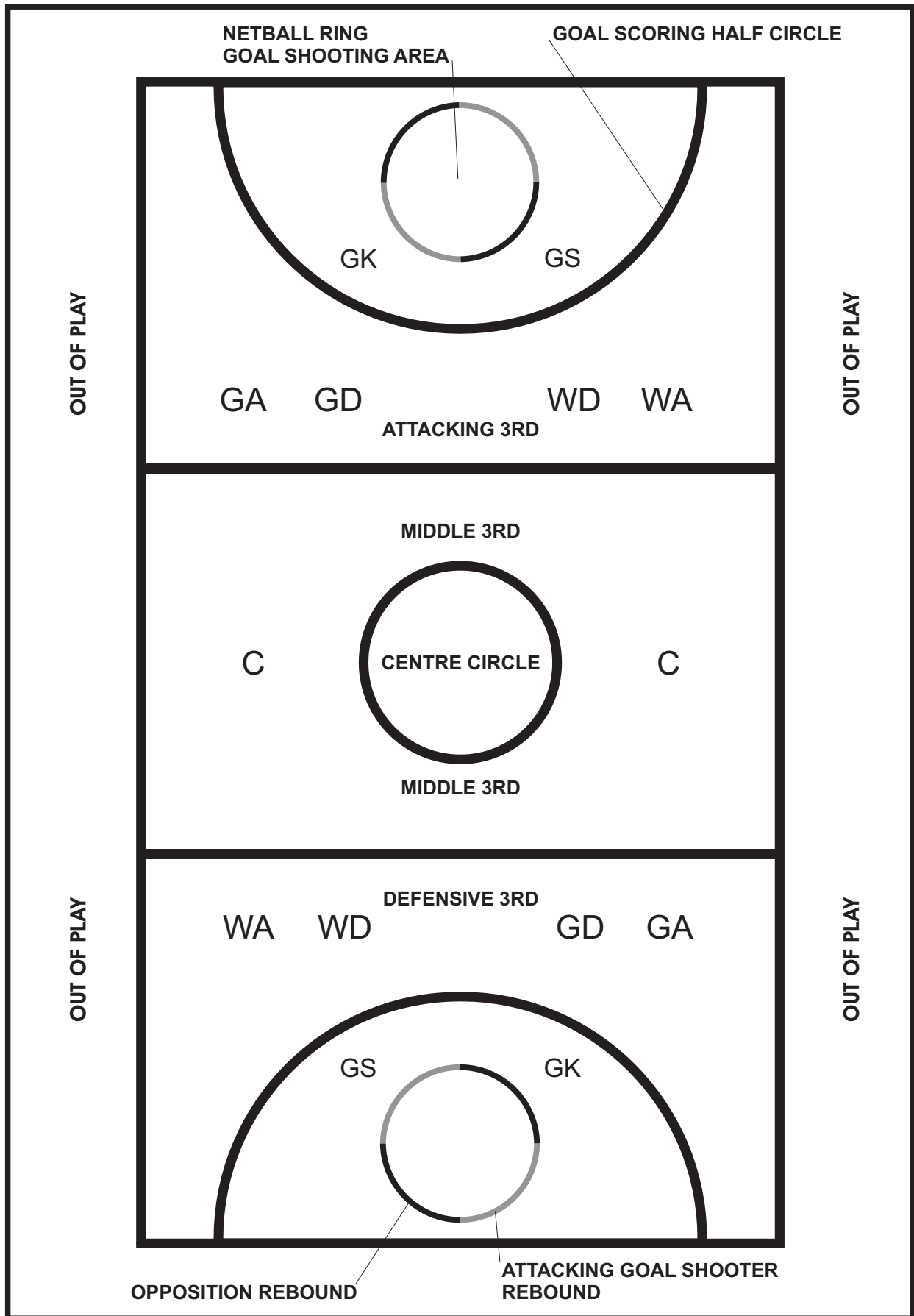

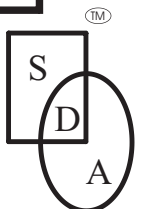
